Mary's Yes: The Courage to Say 'Let It Be So'

Then Mary said, "Here am I, the servant of the Lord let it be with me according to your word (Luke 1:38 NRSV)."

Mary's song from Luke chapter 1 is such a beautiful affirmation of faith. I don't know about you but if an angel approached me with any kind of news, I might be running in the opposite direction. Mary didn't run away. Instead she said, "Here am I!" and ran to see her cousin Elizabeth to find support and share the miraculous news of her own pregnancy. Would I have such a faith as that? Mary's faith leads to poetry of praise:

"My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, for he has looked with favor on the lowly state of his servant. Surely from now on all generations will call me blessed, for the Mighty One has done great things for me, and holy is his name; indeed, his mercy is for those who fear him from generation to generation (Luke 1:46-50)."


Mary's song teaches faith through humble trust in God's promises, courageous obedience to God's will despite uncertainty, and joyful worship of God's desire to overturn injustice.

He has shown strength with his arm; he has scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts. He has brought down the powerful from their thrones and lifted up the lowly; he has filled the hungry with good things and sent the rich away empty. He has come to the aid of his child Israel, in remembrance of his mercy, according to the promise he made to our ancestors, to Abraham and to his descendants forever (Luke 1:51-55)."

The good news is that God favors the lowly, scatters the proud, and fulfills faithfulness across generations, even in difficult circumstances. That doesn't mean that all fear is gone. Mary's yes brought about courage and offers us a story and a song that emboldens our own faith to step out of fear and into trust. So, let's turn inward to examine our own faith. Does it manifest as a heart overflowing with praise, a radical trust in God's redemptive plan?

Let's pray for the courage to simply say, 'Let it be so.' Merry Christmas,


