"Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." - 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 (NIV)

Gratitude is more than just a polished response or a feeling reserved for a special holiday meal; it should be a way of life — a spiritual discipline that shapes our actions. John Wesley, the founder of Methodism,



considered a grateful heart a "mark" of a true Christian. It has been said that Wesley once learned a profound lesson from a poor porter who, despite having very little, was full of infectious joy and praise to God for simply having "life and being, a heart to love him, and a desire to serve him". The story goes that the porter's simple thanksgiving for God's love and care caused Wesley to reflect on his own spiritual state and realize he lacked that same level of genuine gratitude. Now there's a true feel-good story for this season of giving thanks.

In his letter to the Thessalonians, the Apostle Paul calls us to "give thanks in all circumstances". This is challenging. However, Paul is not asking us to be thankful for every difficult situation, such as pain, loss, or injustice. Instead, he invites us to find a place for gratitude within every situation, no matter how hard.

Practicing gratitude shifts our focus from our anxieties and perceived lack to the abundance of God's grace and faithfulness. It reminds us that God's mercies are truly "new every morning" and God's steadfast love endures forever (Lamentations 3:22-23). This shift in focus, this "attitude of gratitude," is a spiritual act that opens the door to God's presence and enables us to see God's hand guiding our lives. I have a colleague in ministry who likes to repeat the old Zig Ziglar quote, "It is your attitude, more than your aptitude, that will determine your altitude". Somewhere in that we can learn to exercise our "gratitude muscle."


Gratitude thrusts us into action, or, as I have heard it said, when we find blessing in what we have been given, our hands naturally open in generosity and service to others. We are called to be channels of blessing, using our gifts of time, talent, and resources to help those in need, remembering Jesus' words that "whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me." (Matthew 25:40).

This Thanksgiving season, let us commit to exercising our "gratitude muscle" not only for one day, but daily. Let us make a determined decision to count our blessings, large and small, and allow our thankfulness to transform our hearts,

our lives, and our communities.


