**BECOME MORE
AND MORE LIKE
JESUS**
(Matthew 28:19-20)

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- **LEFT SIDE:** These are key discipleship qualities (or outcomes).
 - Disciples of Jesus strive to become more and more like Jesus by **following** him in every area of life, **believing** He is who he says He is, **sharing** what God has done for them, and **loving** within a community.
- **RIGHT SIDE:** These are key discipleship quantities (or actions).
 - Disciples of Jesus live this out by **reading** the Bible and **praying** with God every day, having **fellowship** in church and in groups, and **giving** their time, money, and talent back to God.
- **CENTER:** “more and more” signifies an ongoing journey, illustrated by arrows moving in a circular direction and presenting a continuous process of self-reflection, prayer, and pursuit of Christ-likeness with the help of the Holy Spirit. This is true for each element of the model.
- **Scale:** (in the background) represents balance between the LEFT and the RIGHT sides. For example, Love without Reading (Bible, Truth) can create deception and false teaching within a disciple. Truth without Love can create legalism and hard heartedness within a disciple towards God or others.
