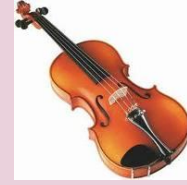

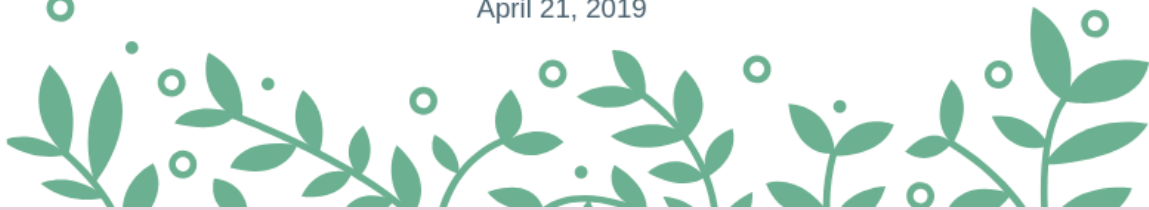

## Trip to Ark Encounter & Creation Museum

The Presbyterian Church of Plum Creek (PCPC) is planning a bus trip with Lenzer's Coach Line to Williamstown, Kentucky.....September 27 and 28, 2019 to experience the Ark Encounter and the Creation Museum.

The cost for this overnight trip will be \$377.00 per person, from ages 9- 99. Price will include bus fee, entrance into both events, hotel accommodations and dinner Saturday evening.

This is the most authentic replica of Noah's ark. The ark stand 7 stories tall and is 1½ football fields long. You will be able to experience close-up encounters with some live animals as well as some life-like recreations. You will be able to travel back in time to meet Noah and some of his family members. Have you ever wondered how Noah built the ark or how he fed and cared for all these animals? All these questions and more will be answered as you tour this large timber-framed structure.
