Hebron Church has a heart and desire to serve Christ outside its doors. This serve happens through the impetus of the Mobilization team that evaluates mission projects, partners with our missionaries and mission agencies through financial support and involvement of the congregation, and reports to the congregation personal “Jesus stories” from the mission experience.

Hebron has a balanced diet of mission partners. We intentionally support missions who serve people with a variety of needs. And we intentionally serve more local missions so that we have greater occasion to be involved not only financially and prayerfully, but as the hands and feet of Jesus.

St. James Fellowship serves the aging, and physically or mentally disabled and those who care for them; The Blessing Board serves those who need home furnishings and supplies; East Liberty Family Health Care Center, those impoverished who need quality health care; P.R.I.S.M., international students in Pittsburgh; Penn Hills Service Association, those who need food and clothing; *YoungLives*, teen moms and their babies; Family Guidance Promise Camp, at-risk youth; Urban Impact, at-risk youth and their families; China Outreach Ministry, Chinese scholars in our area.

Our at-a-distance mission partners are Serge (North Africa), Ethnos360 (Thailand), and Caribbean Youth Network (The Bahamas). The Gospel is the common and key component among these ministries and is freely proclaimed, as is possible in each place.

Each mission/missionary has a liaison on the Mobilization team. The liaisons keep close touch with the missions and bring concerns and opportunities to the team for prayer and participation. We encourage you to watch weekly in the church bulletin on the connect cards for special opportunities and ways you can be involved, according to your gifts and interests.
