Dan Searcy: Non-Hodgkins Lymphoma; starting chemo soon.

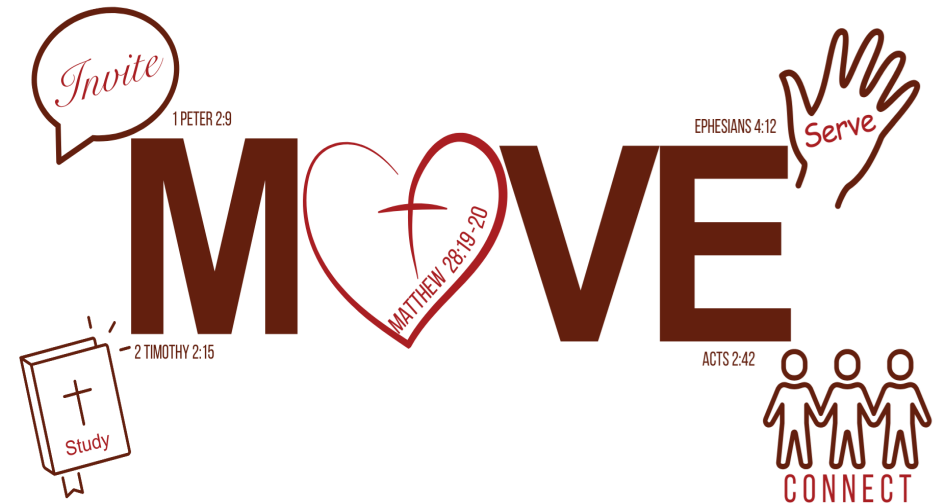
Jenson Shank: Diagnosed with VOD (a disease that effects the liver) (Co-worker's son of Aaron & Jama Guthrie).
