Dallas Shepherd: Chest pain and tachycardia.

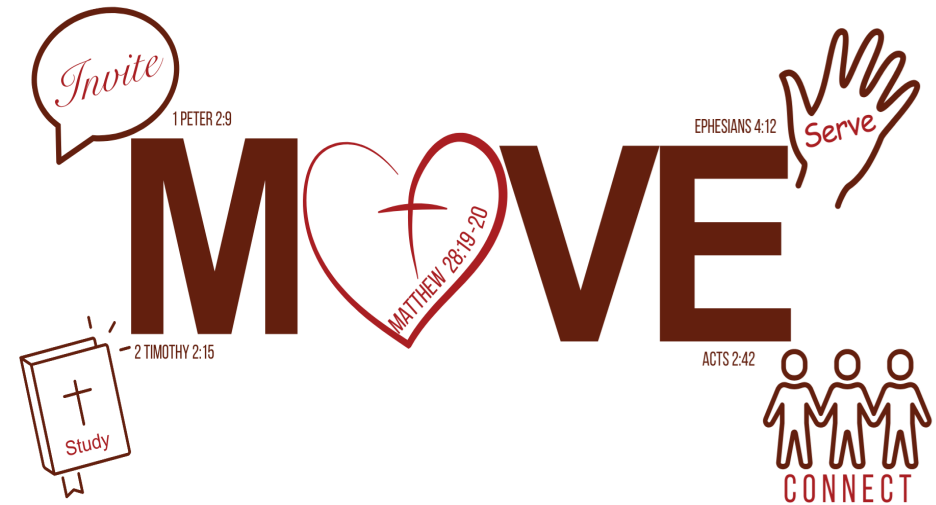
Evelyn Stiers: Began radiation therapy on July 13 for tumor on tongue. (Mother of Brenda Bingham)
