Philippians 4:6-7

Paul offers a different way. Instead of anxiety, he invites us into prayer. Instead of control, into trust. Instead of striving, into surrender.

God’s peace does not come from having everything arranged. It comes from knowing that He is present, attentive, and at work in every detail of your life. Peace is the final mark of a well-organized life.

Where God rules, peace follows. A well-organized life ultimately produces - not a perfect schedule - but a peaceful heart.

Our **Steeple Renovation Campaign** is officially in motion! A **huge thank you** to everyone who has already stepped up with a donation.



So far, we’ve **raised \$39,598.43** toward our goal. Every dollar brings us closer to securing a **\$185,000 matching grant from Sacred Places Indiana, a program of Indiana Landmarks**. Per the grant requirements, all renovations must be completed by **November 2027**.
