Our **Steeple Renovation Campaign** is officially in motion! A **huge thank you** to everyone who has already stepped up with a donation.



So far, we’ve **raised \$41,138.43** toward our goal. Every dollar brings us closer to securing a **\$185,000 matching grant from Sacred Places Indiana, a program of Indiana Landmarks**. Per the grant requirements, all renovations must be completed by **November 2027**.
