Dallas Shepherd: Chest pain and tachycardia.

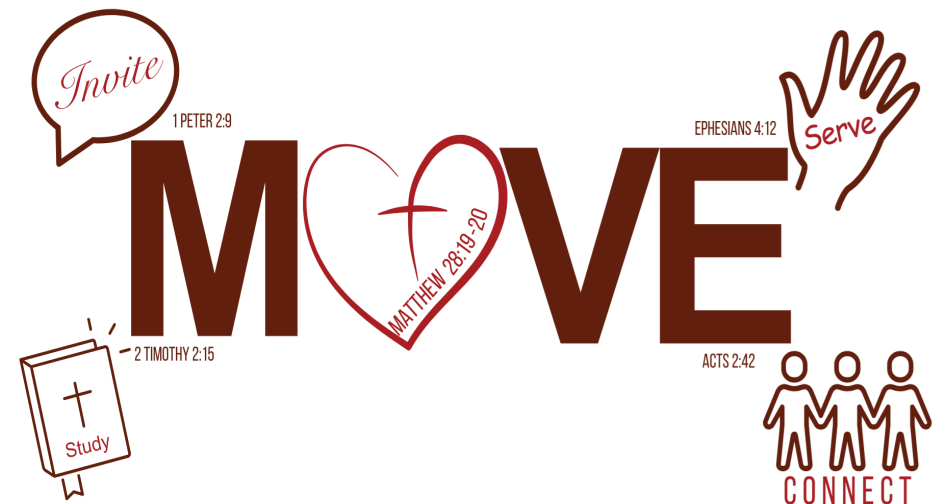
Evelyn Stiers: Receiving radiation for tumor on tongue. (Mother of Brenda Bingham)
