Dan Searcy: Cell transplant complete. Improving but lacks strength. Pray for strength and no infections.

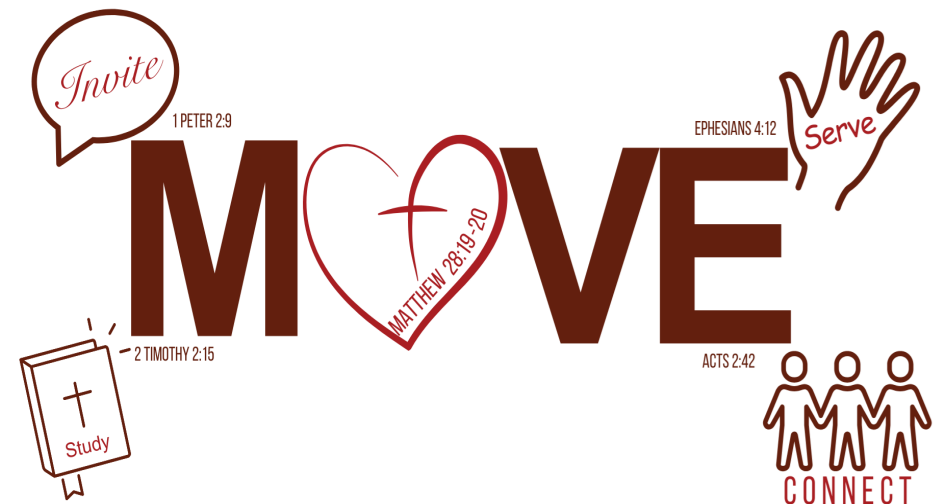
Jenson Shank: Diagnosed with VOD (a disease that effects the liver). (Co-worker's son of Aaron & Jama Guthrie).
