Dan Searcy: Please pray for improved stamina and protection from infection.

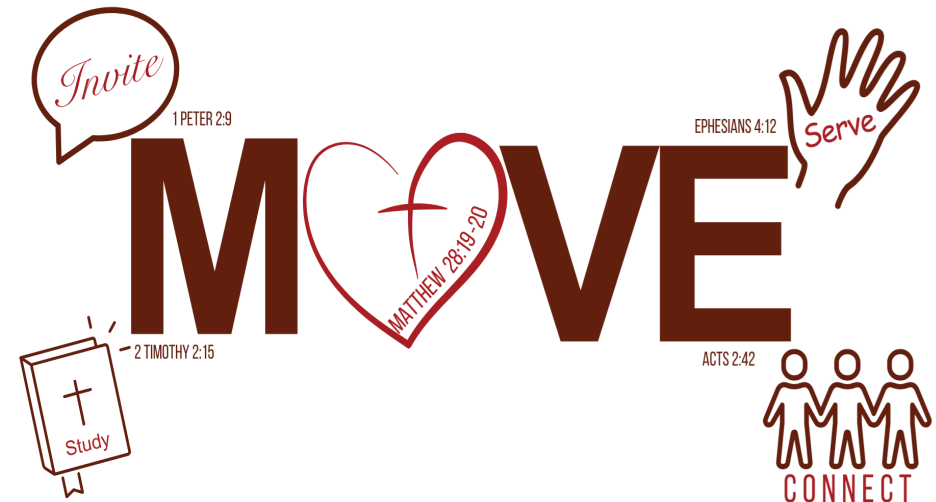
