Assurance of Pardon — *Romans 8:10–11, 14–16*

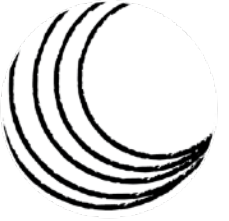
