Today's Sunday in the Church Year: Sexagesima

The Sundays of Septuagesima, *Sexagesima*, and Quinquagesima follow Transfiguration Sunday in the historic church calendar and precede the season of Lent. Their names are Latin for 70, 60, and 50, rough figures for the number of days until Easter. This time is intended to be a kind of pre-Lent, a time to transition from the joy of Christmas and Epiphany to the focus on examination and repentance in Lent.

Lent at Bethlehem



The Season of Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on February 18. Worship services will be held each Wednesday through March 25 at 4:00 and 7:00 pm.

A meal will be served by volunteer groups each Wednesday during Lent. A *potluck* will be held March 25, the last Wednesday service of Lent.



Please bring in your palm branches from last year's Palm Sunday by February 15. They will be burned and used for the Imposition of Ashes before worship on Ash Wednesday, February 18. A collection box is in the Narthex.
