#1: Samaritan's Purse Goats and Dairy Animals Project Supported by your financial gifts, this project provides a family with 4 goats and 1 ram, a source of nutrition and income for the family. Samaritan's Purse provides materials for shelter, start-up food, and veterinary services, all while teaching families how to care for the animals and ensure that the goats remain healthy and productive.

About 150 approved clients shop the pantry one Thursday each month. Their needs are the same as ours: food, toiletries, cleaning supplies, paper products, etc. Items frequently in short supply are canned fruit, canned meat (other than tuna), soup, canned dinners like Spaghetti-Os, Hamburger Helper-type meals, pork & beans, peanut butter, rice, and toilet paper.


