## LERT (Lutheran Early Response Team)



A LERT Training class will be held at Bethlehem on Saturday January 31, 2026. Check-in at 8:30 am (coffee and donuts will be served); class begins at 9am. Lunch and training supplies will be provided. This class, approximately 4 hours,

will help to prepare congregational volunteers to stand ready to assist individuals, families, and the greater community with God given mercy-driven strength and compassion. We will explore how Christ has shown mercy to us, and how we can show our community that same Christ-like mercy during times of need – be it a disaster or simply someone being there to listen and offer comfort.

**So you're a trained LERT volunteer... What now?** Being an LERT trained individual does not require you to make any further commitment to the program. However, it is encouraged so that you can put your training into practice.
