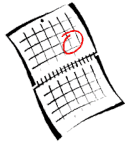

LERT (Lutheran Early Response Team)



A LERT Training class will be held at Bethlehem on Saturday January 31, 2026. Check-in at 8:30 am (coffee and donuts); class begins at 9am.

Lunch and training supplies will be provided. This class, approximately 4 hours, will help to prepare congregational volunteers to stand ready to assist individuals, families, and the greater community with God given

mercy-driven strength and compassion during times of need – be it a disaster or simply someone being there to listen and offer comfort. Being an LERT trained individual does not require you to make any further commitment to the program. However, it is encouraged so that you can put your training into practice.
