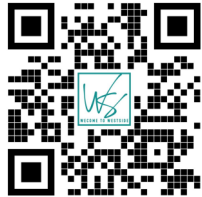

When people have access to enough food, community health improves. Children can focus on schooling without the distraction of hunger. Illness can be more easily fought. Parents don't have to fret about their children's nutrition, & the elderly live longer lives.
The distribution of maize, groundnuts, soybeans, cassava, sweet potatoes, & other vegetable seeds combined with training & ongoing support is providing encouragement & support for small-scale farmers. Through the Sowing Hope project, lives are being transformed.

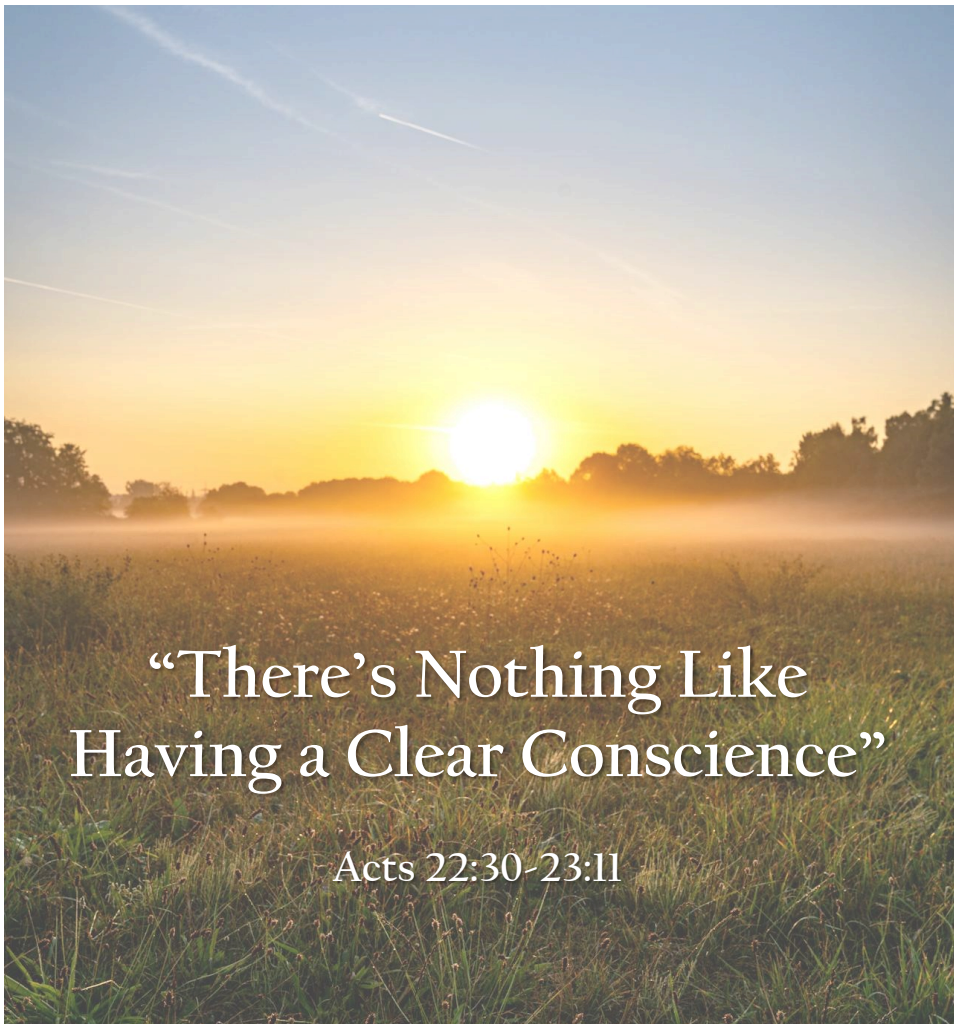
