These relocations have led to a growing poverty rate, reported at 82.4% in 2023. This means over 50% of Venezuelan households are living in extreme poverty. While this leads to uncertainty & instability, it also opens many doors for sharing the love & grace of Christ to those who have lost hope. The Church of the Nazarene is committed to raising up a generation of children & youth who look outwards in missions & live with generosity, grace & commitment to be Christlike in their generation. Please be in prayer for the Nazarenes in Venezuela as they face many difficulties & challenges.
