Cabo Verde: Located 300 miles off the west coast of Africa from Senegal, & on the Africa Region, Cabo Verde, a Portuguese-speaking nation, is an archipelago of 10 volcanic islands on the Africa West Francophone Field. After gaining independence in 1975 as a one-party socialist republic, Cabo Verde in 1990 adopted a revised constitution that stabilized the country, both politically & economically, under a multiparty democratic system. Over 46% of the population is under the age of 25, presenting great opportunities for the future. The Church of the Nazarene was established in Cabo Verde in 1901. It is one of the oldest works of the denomination. Currently, the Church of the Nazarene is the largest Protestant presence in Cabo Verde. There are no longer any missionaries serving in Cabo Verde. All ministries are covered by national leaders, and the church continues to grow.
