

## Family Devotions

### John 6:1-15: Jesus Feeding the Five Thousand

- **Open in Prayer**
- **Read John 6:5-13**
- **Ask these Questions concerning the passage:**
  - What did Jesus ask Philip? (Vs. 5)
    - What is your favorite meal?
  - What was Philip's response? (Vs. 7)
  - How much was 200 Denarii worth? (Vs. 7)
    - Answer: 6-8 months worth of pay. – That's a lot of money!
  - What is wrong with Philip's response?
  - What was Andrew's answer? (Vs. 8-9)
  - How many loaves and fish did the boy have? (Vs. 8-9)
  - What was Jesus' response? (Vs. 10-11)
  - How many people were in the crowd? (Vs. 10)
    - Compare this crowd of 5000 to something in today's world. (stadium, concert, airport, mall, etc.) – That's a lot of people!
  - Was everyone full after Jesus fed them? (Vs. 12)
    - What does it feel like when you are full after eating?
  - How many baskets were leftover? (Vs. 13) –That's a lot of leftovers!
- **Ask the questions concerning Pastor Dean's Sermon:**
  - What was the hymn/song Pastor Dean referred to in the sermon?
    - Answer: Jesus Loves Me This I Know
  - What were the two points of the Sermon?
    - Answer: That we are weak and Jesus is strong
  - Why are we weak?
    - Answer: We are weak because of Sin.
  - Why is Jesus strong?
    - Answer: Because he is God
  - What were the three things told about Jesus' power?
    - Answer: Compassion (Vs. 5), Creator (Vs. 10-11), and All-Sufficient power (Vs 12-13)
  - What does it mean that Jesus has all-sufficient power? – That's a big word!
    - Answer: Jesus is enough to save us from our sins.
  - How does Jesus save us from our sins?
    - Answer: He lived a perfect life (Something we cannot do), He died on the cross (taking our sins upon Himself), and He rose from the dead (beating sin and death).
