John 6:22-40 - Jesus: The Bread of Life (Part 1)

- **Open in Prayer**
- **Read John 6:27, 32, 35, 40**
- **Ask these Questions concerning the passage:**
 - Who did the crowd go looking for? (Vs. 22-24)
 - What did they ask Jesus? (Vs. 25)
 - What did Jesus say to them? (Vs. 26-27)
 - Who did the crowd compare Jesus to? (Vs. 31)
 - What is Manna? (Exodus 16:31)
 - What did Jesus say in verse 35? Jesus said, “I Am _____.”
 - Who comes to Jesus? (Vs. 37)
 - What did Jesus come down to do? (Vs. 38)
 - What is the will of the Father? (Vs. 39-40)
- **Ask these Questions concerning Pastor Dean’s Sermon:**
 - What is your favorite way to eat bread? What is your favorite kind of bread? What does bread symbolize?
 - Grilled cheese, my mom’s sourdough bread (of course), it symbolizes health and life.
 - Jesus symbolizes the bread of life because He is the only way to eternal life.
 - What were the three points of the sermon about the bread of life?
 - The bread of life is greater than physical bread (Vs. 22-27)
 - The bread of life is greater than Moses and Manna (Vs. 28-34)
 - The bread of life is given to God’s people through Jesus Christ (Vs. 35-40)
 - Who is the bread of life? (Vs. 35)
 - Why is the bread of life greater than physical bread?
 - What was the illustration Pastor Dean gave about bacon?
 - Answer: A commercial about a dog who loved His owner because of the bacon dog treat.
 - How did this apply to the sermon? – The crowd was being like the dog.
 - Why is the bread of life greater than Moses and Manna?
 - Who is greater? LeBron James or Michael Jordan?
 - Who is greater? Jesus or Moses? Why?
 - Answer: Jesus is not just a prophet like Moses, he is the Son of God and is equal to the Father.
 - How is the bread of life given to God’s people?
 - Answer: Through Jesus as the provider of the bread of life and as the actual bread of life.
 - What were the three highlights of verses 37-40?
 - God chooses His people and promises to save them. (Vs. 37)
 - Jesus saves them and accomplishes God’s promise. (Vs. 37-38)
 - Our response is to believe in Jesus for salvation and eternal life. (Vs. 39-40)
 - Have you come to Jesus with full acknowledgement of your sins and trust in Him for salvation? Do you want to be saved from your sins?
