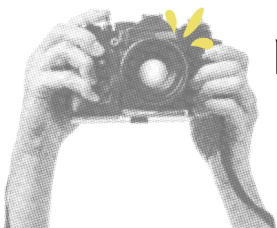

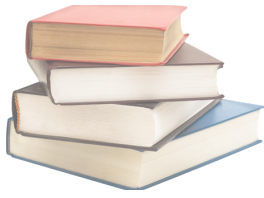
Packing Hope: Serving Local Foster & Kinship Families

Sunday Morning Building Entrances Updated

Thank you for your cooperation and flexibility during this time of transition in the move of our children. With all new things we find there may be some aspects that need to be tweaked to function in the best way possible for our church family. With that in mind, we will be reopening the Office Entry doors on Sunday mornings. This entrance should be used primarily for families checking in children but will be open for everyone to use. The hallway outside the offices and leading to the bathrooms will no longer be restricted.

This change will alter our check-in area slightly. We will still have check-in hosts stationed just inside the double doors coming from the Breezeway and we will now have check-in hosts stationed in the Office Lobby. Families should then proceed to the Preschool hallway (left of the offices) to enter the Children's wing. We will have a team member at the doors at the bottom of the ramp verifying that all kids have been checked in and have a name tag. At pick-up, parents should go directly to the Preschool hallway and show their Security tag to the team member at the same doors before heading to their children's classrooms. Please follow one-way traffic for dropoff and pickup by continuing all the way through the Children's wing and exiting through the Elementary Worship Area.
