Student Ministries Update

For the past two months, several individuals have stepped up to serve in Student Ministry, and we are deeply grateful for all they have been doing. We eagerly anticipate expanding our team as we continue searching for our next Student Ministry Pastor.

We are excited about the future of our 412 Student Ministry and would like to share the vision for some upcoming changes:

1. May 17 will be our final Sunday morning for Student Ministry programming. As we transition into summer and beyond, we will prioritize integrating our students into the life of the Church on Sunday mornings. We envision students participating in the Worship Center with their friends, families and elders, serving amidst the body of LCC, and being a more present example to our older and younger generations. This approach has proven to be highly effective in helping students shift from hearing about their parents' faith to making their faith their own as they move through high school and into college or the workforce. Additionally, there is immense value in having multiple generations worship, learn, and serve together.

We already have our next Generations Sunday planned for May 24 so this will create a natural transition to having students join us in the Worship Center and serving on teams as they choose.

With this change, our focus will shift to enhancing our Sunday night 412 Student Ministry programming. We will continue with The Koin as it has been through May 31, and then have camp and special activities throughout the summer. In the fall, we intend to create a highly focused Sunday night program that will include weekly student-led worship, biblical teaching, small group discussions, fun activities and hopefully still a meal or snack bar available. We will need not only our current team, but even more team members to ensure the success of this change. 2. We are also pleased to announce Heather Collins as the Interim Leader of 412 Student Ministry. Heather has over 15 years of student ministry leadership experience and 7 years of children's ministry leadership experience. She is passionate about serving the Lord, collaborating amongst a team, and serving students. Appointing an interim leader will help with organization, communication, vision and spiritual discernment amidst the team that is currently serving. 3. Lastly, we are actively seeking our new Student Ministry Pastor. We have received a substantial number of applications and are beginning initial conversations with these candidates. Please be in fervent prayer for the Lord to guide us in selecting the individual He desires for our Student Ministry here at LCC.
