

# A Message From Jeff...

## ALERT—WHITETAIL DEER ON THE MOVE

It's that time of year when deer go into the rutting season (mating season). This is when hormonally-distracted deer are more prone to jump out on the road causing risk and danger to motorists. As a practical advice for those of us living/traveling on rural roads, be sure to especially exercise caution during the hours of sunrise and sunset.

Two important rules to remember are:

- 1. Reduce your speed by 5-10 mph when driving at night during the rut season of October/November. This creates more of a braking cushion to help prevent collisions with deer.
- 2. Brake hard if a deer appears in your vehicle's path, but *don't swerve to avoid a deer!* You may have some damage from the impact, but those who seek to swerve face greater injury or death from rolling their vehicle.

In Psalm 42:1, the psalmist penned this lyric—"As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for You, my God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God..."

May we each demonstrate a growing appetite for a deeper relationship with God.
