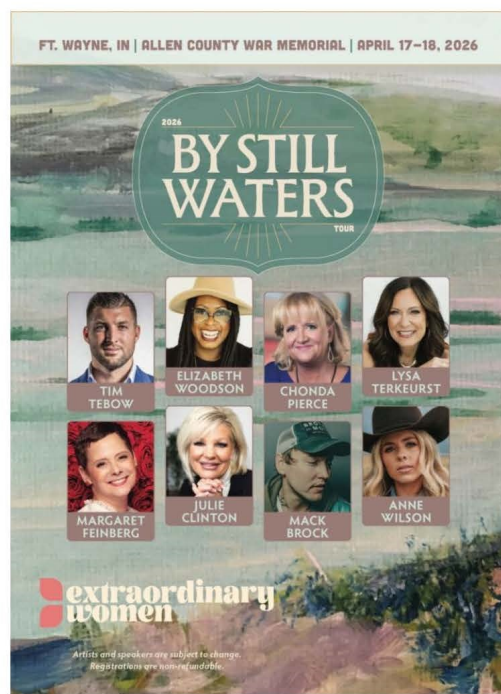
Mahoning Valley Christian Service Camp
