TOPICAL NON-PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION / PERMISSION SLIP

Topical non-prescription medication includes, but is not limited to:

- Sunscreen
- Diaper rash cream
- Antibiotic ointment

SUNSCREEN POLICY:

Trinity Lutheran Early Childcare Center will apply sunscreen to children prior to going outside. Trinity Lutheran ECC will provide sunscreen for all children, **however, all donations are greatly appreciated.** Parents whose children need a specific brand of sunscreen because of allergies or other medical reasons may provide that sunscreen with a doctor’s note and medication permission form. Special sunscreen must be labeled with the child’s name and used only by that child. Staff will post a notice to this effect in the classroom.

The sunscreen that Trinity Lutheran ECC supplies will:

- Be PABA Free, water-resistant and have an SPF of at least 30
- Be applied during the months of May through September and other times when the sun seems intense.
- Will not be applied to infants under 12 months of age unless specified in writing by a parent.
- **School-age children may apply sunscreen to themselves with adult supervision.**

DIAPER RASH CREAM

Trinity Lutheran ECC will apply diaper rash cream provided by the parents as needed for children in the Infant, Transition and Toddler rooms only.

ANTIBIOTIC OINTMENT

Trinity Lutheran ECC will apply antibiotic ointment to abrasions occurring while the child is in care. Appropriate first aid techniques will be used per Red Cross First Aid training.
