- Facility
 - Tobin Landscaping has completed all of the church's updated landscaping. This is the first job within the Church Refresh campaign.
 - Our sanctuary access point (AP) is finally online and allowing a wifi connection. Norman Alan was able to find multiple issues which were preventing a connection. Glenn Davidson also picked up a long-range AP from Norman Alan, so we now have a strong signal throughout all of the sanctuary.
 - The AED Pediatric pads arrived and are in the black AED case. The AED is now available for use for any age if needed.

 - Keystone Family Alliance
 - Jordan Hunt was with us on Sunday, June 8th. She was encouraged by the initial response from our congregation. She is interested in coming back for an evening to provide greater detail of how GAC can be involved for those who signed up and any others who want to gain more information.

Staff spent an entire day going through the Power Church database export of 1935 names to provide those who will be entered into Planning Center.
