A big win is the entire last year. God has been so good, as we saw in the finance report, blessing us financially. We had over 140 individuals give their lives to Jesus, and if you add in the ministries the Church had some contact with, that number goes over 250. What is exciting is that this range includes kids as young as four years old to individuals in their seventies. So far in 2026, we have had four people give their lives to Jesus. Our attendance has been significantly higher over the last year and continues to rise. So far in January, we are up by nearly 100 people from 2025. While many churches are still trying to reach the number of people they did in 2019, we have blown by that number. We are approximately 100 people away from having to figure out a third service time on Sunday morning. If we match the growth rate we experienced in 2025, we will have to move to three services by some point in 2027. God is so good, and I am so thankful I get to serve with each one of you. I do not know what the next year will hold, but God is doing some big things at Greensburg Alliance Church.
