Sunday Morning Adult Growth Classes - May 6 & 13

9:15am: The Post-Resurrection Appearances of Jesus - Teacher: Michael Black - Classroom: 240

The Easter season is arguably the most important part on the Christian calendar because it celebrates the resurrection of Jesus. But what happened after his followers approached the empty tomb? One of the realities that we often forget is that Jesus appeared to his followers many times for 40 days after his resurrection. These appearances served as a powerful driving force for the message of the Gospel that radically changed the world over the next 2000 years. In this study we will be examining the various accounts that we have of Jesus appearing to his followers. These accounts are an exciting reminder that an empty tomb was only the beginning.

10:45am: God’s Grace is Greater - Teacher: Lee Calisti - Classroom: 250/260

In the DVD study, God's Grace is Greater, Kyle Idleman reminds us that God's grace is greater than our setbacks and failures. In these six sessions we will learn that no sin is so great or bitterness so deep that God cannot redeem it for His glory. God's plan is to overcome your past, redeem your pain, and re-write your story so that you can be a healthy minister of Christ.

Sunday Morning Adult Growth Classes - May 20 through June 24

9:15am: Jesus and the Feasts of Israel - Teacher: Ed Kerr - Classroom: 240

Throughout the Bible many of the significant accounts of God moving take place in the context of the Feasts of Israel and the Sabbath. Did you know that these celebrations clearly point to God’s redemptive plan through Jesus? In the feasts we see how the Messiah Jesus is the fulfillment of God’s longstanding promises.

It is important to recognize that without a basic understanding of the Sabbath and the Feasts of Israel, we will be missing a huge part of the interpretive context when we approach the Scriptures. In this study we hope to enrich our worship of God by learning about the origin and symbolism of the Old Testament feasts and holidays given by God to his people. This class will be a mixture of teaching, video, and discussion.


