9:15am: Genesis 1-11 - Teacher: Jared Burns - Classroom: 240

The Bible starts off with an amazing statement: In the beginning God. This letterhead addresses the One who is both the Word, and the Creator. Yet, popular culture seeks to detract from both. Culture seeks to identify the God of the Old Testament as a heartless impersonal god, distinct from the New Testament Christ.

In this class we will explore the act of creation, the fall of man, the flood, and decline of humanity leading up to Abraham. We will seek to celebrate the themes of love, grace, salvation, and redemption that overflow from Genesis 1-11. Counter to culture, we'll be reminded that the Old Testament God is the same God who is our loving Savior – still a Creator – as He creates in us new life.

When God's people unite and call on his name, powerful things happen in our world!

It has been said that prayer is the primary work of God's people. When a believer approaches God's throne of grace with confidence (Hebrews 14:1) there is always the potential to see amazing things happen as we connect with our Creator.

Cancelled Postal Stamps & Used Christian Literature Collection

Collecting cancelled postal stamps is an ongoing ministry, so please remember to keep saving throughout the year. The income from the postal stamps goes to support preparation, publishing, and distribution of a Spanish language curriculum for Sunday Schools. Remember that only stamps affixed to envelopes can be processed; do not remove stamps from envelopes or trim around stamps. It is best to submit all or half of the envelope with the stamp attached since they need to be in excellent condition in order to sell to collectors.

We also collect used Christian-based literature such as the Daily Bread devotional booklets, which we send to My CRI/Mission Cry. Please drop off stamps and booklets at the Welcome Center at your convenience.


Vacation Bible School Volunteers
