From the Pastor's Desk

1 Car 1 Bag - Sunday, October 14

Did you know that each night in the United States, 17.4 million families go to bed hungry? In addition to that, 6.9 million families experience ongoing food insecurity. That means that entire households don't always know where their next meal is coming from. On Sunday, October 14 we have the opportunity to do something about it.

Each year the Salvation Army provides over 56 million meals through the services it provides, and we're partnering with them with 1 Car 1 Bag. Here's how it works. On that Sunday we're asking each family to bring a bag of non-perishable food (canned goods preferably with pull tabs; dry pasta; pasta sauce; macaroni & cheese, etc.) and then leave it on the ground behind your car when you come to church. During both services we'll collect the bags with the church van. (If we have inclement weather, please place your bags directly in the van which will be parked near the entrance to the church.) All items will be taken to the Salvation Army. This is a great opportunity for us to do something tangible to help those in need in our community. Sunday Morning Adult Growth Classes - October 7 through November 4

(Note - No classes on Sunday, November 11)

9:15am: A Christian Perspective on World Religions and Cults - Teacher: Ed Kerr - Classroom: 240

This study will explore the history, background, and beliefs of the world's most prominent religions and cults from a Christian perspective. We will learn about what makes them different from the truth of the Gospel. In doing so, we will explore what we believe and why it is important to have an understanding on how the Biblical view differs from those of other faiths. When we have an understanding of the beliefs of others, we will be better equipped to share with them the life changing message of Jesus!

10:45am: Counter Culture - Teacher: Lee Calisti - Classroom: 250/260

The Bible is clear on a number of issues: Who God is and who we are. Who Christ is and what He has done. What it means to follow Christ, and why this matters for eternity.

In this study we will explore how these truths affect how we respond to the social issues of our day. How does the Gospel respond to the realities of poverty, slavery, abortion, sexual immorality, the degradation of marriage, the neglect of orphans and widows, racism, and persecution?

The truths of the Gospel should compel us to a contrite, compassionate, and courageous personal response to social issues in the culture. Using Biblical foundations, practical illustrations, and personal exhortations, this study is a pointed yet winsome call for readers to faithfully follow Christ in countercultural ways. There will be a cost. There will be a reward. Do Christians in the contemporary church have the courage to counter the culture?

Sunday Morning Adult Growth Classes - November 18 through December 30

(Note - No classes on Sunday, December 23)

9:15am: Christmas Revisited - Teacher: Michael Black - Classroom: 240

While the Christmas Story may be very familiar to us on a superficial level, it is very common for people to be surprised by the details when someone takes the time to tease out its nuances. Many times these nuances have theological implications for us as believers that help us understand the nature and character of God.

The goal of this study is to closely examine the details of the Christmas Story and bring a fresh perspective that takes the Biblical text and the cultural perspective of first century Palestine seriously. Through this study we will affirm facts, refute myths, and reaffirm the relevance of many aspects of what we know about the importance of the coming of Jesus.

10:45am: The Reason for God - Teacher: Mike Buriok - Classroom: 250/260

In this unique study, Pastor and Author Timothy Keller of Redeemer Presbyterian Church in NYC, meets unscripted with a group of people over six sessions to address their doubts and objections to Christianity. Using literature, philosophy, real-life experiences, and the Bible, Keller and the group explore the truth of Christianity. This study places an emphasis on learning how to dialogue with those who are struggling with the claims of Christianity. The sessions will help you think about how to engage others on the six common objections to Christianity you see below.

- 1- Is the Bible a myth?
 - 2- Is there only one way to God?
 - 3- Why does God have so many rules?
 - 4- Why does God allow suffering?
 - 5- Why has the church done so much wrong?
 - 6- How can God send people to Hell?

Roos Fall Update

Early August saw the departure of five of the six interns and a slow down of ministry as we rested and reworked where God is leading us. For three days we met together with our teammates, the Hilstads, to rest and reframe. We spent many hours enjoying God's creation, and many hours dreaming and scheming, as God led us to the next steps in ministry here in France. One of the things that became abundantly clear during our time together is the realization that we are better together in ministry.

We have started our ministry again by hosting weekly conversation groups where people can encounter Christ followers and improve their English. We invite people into relationships with us, and when the time is right, with Jesus. Our time is focused on providing on-ramps into the Christian life and developing the people around us to minister and serve.

We also met together with all the C&MA workers in the Paris area to clearly define how to better work together and bring clarity to the mission of bringing transformational Gospel access to Parisians. These were a good three days together with hard but meaningful conversations. God has also given us opportunity to help give leadership to the overall France mission field.

We have restarted the services "Connected Worship" which are weekly worship services designed with invited guests in mind. They are level three in our threshold model of bringing people to thresholds where they are invited into deeper relationships and deeper understanding of Jesus.

Fayth is back at Black Forest Academy in her junior year where she is doing great and settling in. Hannah is doing online schooling again this year and has also settled well into this year's schooling. We are still dealing with some ongoing medical issues and looking for God's healing. We thank you for your continued prayers for our ministry and family.
