OSYC BREAKOUT SESSIONS

WHO IS GOD?

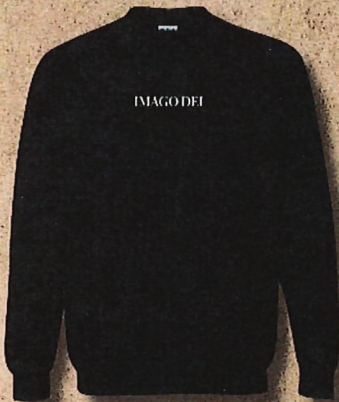
