- What is the significance of v6a?
- Sometimes Christians say things like "I don't want to be rich. I just want to be secure." In what way does **v9** comment on this desire?
- Why does God care about violence done to the earth (Note he repeats the same phrase **v8b** and **17b**)? What does this tell us about God?
- Why do people trust in Idols?
- Read **v14**: Why does God describe the final state this way

# **APPLICATION**

- The proud are greedy like the grave (v5). Do you struggle with seeking more and more? What brings you lasting happiness?
- Should Christians be environmentalists? Discuss. Are there any dangers in this?
- What idols do people worship today? In what ways are they powerless and foolish?
- What are your experiences with practicing silence before the Lord? How may we practice being silent before God?
- God's describes his ultimate goal for the world as the knowledge of his glory is spreading. How might that impact how we live now?
