(Located off South Branch River Road)

## **Accommodations:**

### **Hampshire Park**

Lodging is rustic. You will be staying in a cinderblock bunkhouse with a central bath facility. Bunkhouses are NOT air-conditioned, but the dining hall, bathrooms, and showers ARE air-conditioned! You may want to bring a fan to keep you cool as you sleep and to block out the sound of others who snore!

# What to Bring List:

1. Bible
2. Sleeping Bag or linens for a single bunkbed
3. Pillow
4. Towel, soap, etc.
5. Shorts (see notes below for modest attire)
6. Flashlight
7. Water bottle
8. Spending money for sodas, snacks, etc.
9. Shower sandals
10. Light jacket or sweatshirt
11. Any medication you might be taking
12. Money for laundry (optional)
13. Work clothes (long pants must be worn at the sites, jeans are preferred)
14. Leisure clothes (shorts are okay at camp, but not “short-shorts”)
15. Bug Spray
16. Sun Block
17. Baseball cap (optional)
18. Closed-toed shoes
19. Rain jacket
20. Floor fan (optional)

**Note:** Modest attire is expected during staff training and during the camp week, both of students and of our staff. Short shorts, sagging shorts or tank tops with thin straps are inappropriate in a camp ministry setting. If you are uncertain or have doubts about a specific piece of clothing it is best to err on the side of caution and leave it at home. Outside of the rooms all males are required to wear t-shirts (well, girls are too, but we figured you knew that).

Staffers will receive **2 shirts**. Staffers must wear their staff shirts on the first day of camp and every afternoon after returning from the work site (after a shower, of course!). Staffers wear regular t-shirts at the work site. The CD will coordinate washing staff shirts on free day (Wed). This summer’s color shirt is NAVY BLUE.

## **Directions to Hampshire Park (Romney, WV):**

**From Richmond and points south:** (Approx. drive time from Richmond: 3 hours, 15 minutes)

- Take I95 north to exit #133 (Rt. 17 North to Warrenton)
- Take Rt. 17 North toward Warrenton for 26 miles at which point you will come to a 3-way intersection - take a RIGHT and continue following signs for Rt. 17 North toward Winchester. (From here on, follow the signs very closely - you will soon need to exit RIGHT in order to stay on 17 north)
- Once you exit RIGHT, go approx. 9 miles and follow signs for I 66 West (this will be a LEFT exit)
- Stay on I 66 West until you see signs for I 81N. Take I 81N toward Winchester.
- At Exit 310, follow the signs for Rt. 37 N/W. This is a bypass around Winchester. Follow this for approximately 2 miles.
- Take the Romney exit. AT the bottom of the ramp, turn LEFT (Rt. 50 West). Follow Rt. 50 all the way into Romney (about 40 miles).
- When you arrive into Romney, you will go through 2 traffic lights. At the bottom of the hill, just before you cross the bridge, turn LEFT onto River Road.
- Go 3.5 miles and Hampshire Park will be on your LEFT.

**From Northern Virginia:** (Approx. drive time from Northern Virginia: 2 hours, 30 minutes)

- From 495 Capital Beltway, take I 66 West to I 81 North.
- At Exit 310, follow the signs for Rt. 37 N/W. This is a bypass around Winchester. Follow this for approximately 2 miles.
- Take the Romney exit. AT the bottom of the ramp, turn LEFT (Rt. 50 West). Follow Rt. 50 all the way into Romney (about 40 miles).
- When you arrive into Romney, you will go through 2 traffic lights. At the bottom of the hill, just before you cross the bridge, turn LEFT onto River Road.
- Go 3.5 miles and Hampshire Park will be on your LEFT.
