Position Title: Pastor of Family Ministries and Worship

Position Type: Full time

Position Summary: To connect with and strengthen families and children in order to see them reach their full potential in Christ, and to shepherd people in authentic worship.

Reports To: Lead Pastor

Direct Reports: Children's Ministry team (Nursery to Grade 6), Worship Team (band & vocals), Tech Team (Sound & Media).

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Family Ministries

- Develop opportunities and ministries that will serve to connect with and disciple the young families of our church and community.
- Provide oversight and leadership for the Children's Ministry Team (Nursery to Grade 6).
- Teach children to walk in authentic relationship with God through intentional training and practical expressions of faith.
- Develop creative ways of connecting with and supporting parents (periodic family events, parenting resources, training parents on their spiritual role in the home, etc.)
- Equip parents as the primary spiritual influencers in their children's lives.
- Work with the Senior Pastor and the church leadership to develop a vision for Family Ministries that is in alignment with the overall vision and direction of the church. Create a plan to implement the vision.
- Oversee "Plan to Protect" training, administration, and implementation across ministries.
- Create and oversee the Family Ministries Budget.
- Attend Staff meeting weekly.
- Participate in Sunday services and other duties as requested by the Senior Pastor.

2. Worship Ministry

- Fulfill the role of Primary Worship Leader.
- Foster and lead GTC into authentic expressions of worship during our corporate gatherings.
- Recruit for and work closely with teams for Sunday morning worship.
- Recruit for and work closely with teams for the planning of special events (Christmas and Easter).
- Pastor the team leaders and team members within the Worship Ministry.
- Provide regular training and development for all team members.

- Work with Student Ministries to identify and develop talent from among the students with the goal of involving the next generation as an integral part of the main worship service.
- Provide dependable planning, scheduling and support for worship ministry teams.
- Create and oversee the budget for Worship Ministries.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A mentoring, discipling and pastoring mindset that calls people to places of greater intimacy in their walk with Christ.
- Self-starter, open to input and mentoring.
- Leadership capacity to be able to recruit and build healthy teams.
- Proven experience in a similar role is an asset.
- Agreement with Glad Tidings' vision, goals and statement of faith.
- A post-secondary degree in a related field is an asset, but not necessarily a requirement.
- Credentialing with the PAOC, or a commitment to obtain credentials within three years of hire.

WHO WE ARE:

Glad Tidings Pentecostal church is an established congregation serving over 160 members and attendants. Our average Sunday morning attendance is approximately 130 people. The demographic mix is nicely balanced with a growing number of young families and couples, and a significant number of people in the 50plus age bracket. We are located in the community of Arnprior, approximately 30 minutes West of Ottawa. We are a church family that is excited about fulfilling our God-given purpose in our community and beyond.
