- f) Maintains ministry database with current, accurate, and accessible information
- g) Provides pastoral care and prayer support for youth and young adults in need

- i) Oversees ministry expenditures with fiscally responsible management of ministry budget
- j) Serves on Pastoral Team to provide other ministries to the broader church congregation
