

2019 Youth Mission Trip

Dates: June 23rd - 28th

Purpose of Trip:

LLC 2019 youth missions trip will serve two primary purposes. First, we seek to glorify God, by supporting our sister church, The Well Baptist Church, in their efforts to plant a Christian community that will effectively reach the lost of Venice, FL. Our team will be participating in community engagement opportunities and various community service activities aimed at drawing awareness to the church plant and its ministries. Secondly, we hope to provide an experience with Christ that will positively affect the relationships our youth have with one another and Christ through service.

Transportation:

The students will fly to Tampa, FL or other airport from one of our regional airports. We will be renting cars/vans for transportation while serving at The Well Baptist Church.

Meals:

Sunday, June 23rd - Students will need to purchase their own dinner or eat prior to arriving at LLC to depart for the airport.

Monday, June 24th - Thursday, June 28th - Students and leaders will prepare and eat breakfast and dinner at the guest house. Lunches will be prepared at the guest house and carried with us each day to eat in the field. Students should be prepared to assist leadership in preparing meals.

Thursday, June 28th - Students will purchase their own dinner at the airport. Each student will need spending money for this purpose. \$15-20 will be more than sufficient for this meal.

* Youth should not let the cost of the trip to be a barrier to their participation. If a family wishes for their student to participate, but can not afford the trip, they should contact Pastor Jon. LLC desires for every youth to have access to its events and programs.

** All costs are estimates based on prices at the time of this documents publication. LLC will work hard to be good financial stewards, seeking the best possible prices for all associated costs. However, we can not guarantee a price at this time.

Fundraisers:

In order to support students who have financial need, we will hold one or more fundraisers to raise money for the cost of our trip. We are asking parents to support the trip by helping develop/plan the fundraiser(s). Possibilities may include volunteering at Hershey Park, car wash, dinner, etc.

Deposit & Final Payment:

We are asking students who are planning to go to make a non-refundable deposit of \$225.00 by Sunday, March 31st. This will cover the cost of plane tickets. After all deposits have been received the tickets will be purchased. A final payment of approximately \$100.00 will be due Sunday, June 9th. If your family has a student(s) who would like to attend, but circumstances make it difficult to afford the cost of the trip, please speak with Pastor Jon and LLC will work to make a way for your student to attend. We want all students interested in attending, to be a part of our trip.

Participation & Behavior

All students will be required to actively participate in all ministry opportunities, team activities, meal preparation, cleaning, and all other activities while in the field. Students will be expected to obey the rules set forth by the team leaders and more importantly live lives that reflect the call and directives of Christ. Additionally, students should always be seeking ways to encourage, support, and bless one another. While in Florida, we are representatives LLC and The Well Baptist Church, as such students must be aware of how their words and actions will reflect on both churches and seek to live and speak in such a way that casts a positive light on each congregation. If students fail to live or act in accordance with these directives they will be disciplined and/or removed fully removed from ministry.

Insurance:

Each student and volunteer attending the mission trip is required to have active health insurance. Parents are welcome to purchase additional travel insurance to cover any financial loss if students are not able to participate after making the ticket purchase. Pastor Jon can help families find travel insurance.

Application and Approval:

Students will be required to submit an LLC Mission Trip Application. The youth leadership will review each application and will accept all qualified students who wish to participate. However, students should know that participation in LLC youth events, worship services, or other activities do not guarantee acceptance to the missions team. We will only accept students who demonstrate a genuine and progressively developing Christian maturity and who are emotionally and physically prepared for the rigors of the trip.
