

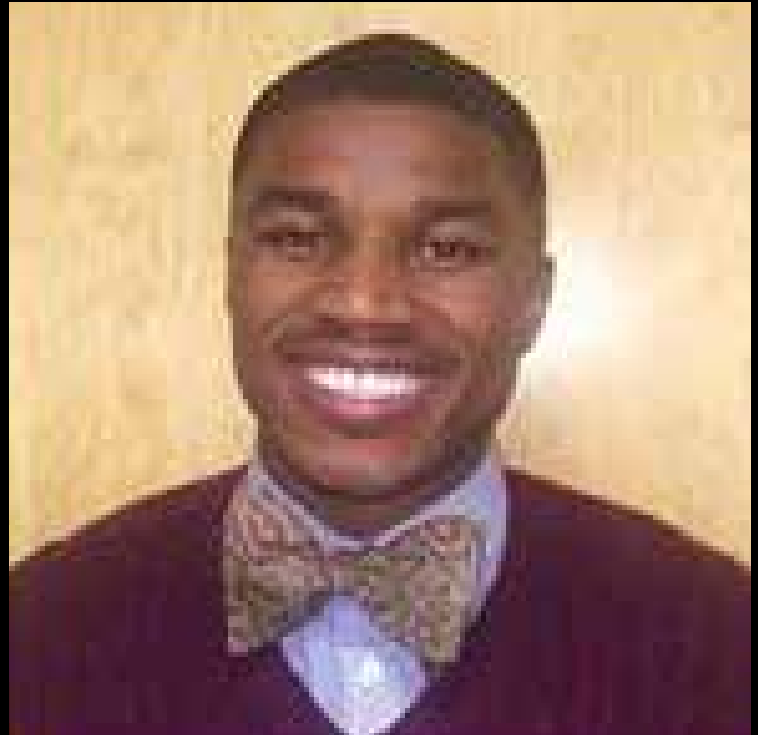
Mr. Jeremy Medlock
