Using the feedback generated during a church family round table meeting in late January, our church council identified three ministry opportunities that resonated with the congregation. In line with our mission statement to Be Known for Knowing Jesus, we sensed that a ministry that helps meet the needs of the community right around our geographical neighbourhood was needed. **Community Roots**, a ministry established by Jubilee Mennonite Church, has been reaching out to this community for over a decade. They are looking for partnerships. We can be more effective partnering with a ministry that has already established relationships, ministries and expertise instead of starting from scratch on our own. We look forward to how this might evolve in the coming months.

Multiply, our denomination's Missions and Church Planting Network approached NKMB about sponsoring an eventual church plant reaching our Sikh neighbours with the Good News. This would be a long term mission. It will require a dedicated core team, a prayerful and patient disposition and a lot of support from everyone here. As is for every follower of Jesus anywhere, anytime, our Mission to Invite Others to Know Jesus, is front and central.

Often, fulfilling this mission involves risk, dedication and an abiding trust in the gifting and wisdom of the Holy Spirit. Is God calling you to be part of the core team that will shape this outreach in the years to come?

For years our church has been formally and informally assisting in our Provincial Denomination's Camping Ministry in Northern Manitoba at **Simon House Bible Camp**. I think all of us have a heart to reach & assist our first nations friends and neighbours, but most of us struggle to know where to begin. Simon House Bible Camp has for years been doing exactly that. Why not come alongside the Camp and assist them? Why not 'adopt' this ministry and help them in anyway we can? We have so many talents and gifts within our church family that we believe could help equip Simon House to speak the love of Christ into a part of Manitoba that often struggles to find hope.

It's our hope that God will raise up leaders who are willing to serve as team leaders to raise up resources to organize and deliver outreach opportunities for everyone here at NKMB to help out in some way. Is God calling you?

WE'RE HIRING


