## **Job Description:**

Counselors stay in dorms with the campers when camp is in session. This will help you build intentional relationships with each camper to help them experience Jesus Christ. Counselors should be people who genuinely care about investing in the lives of others. They should be able to provide an environment in which their faith in Christ is reflected in how they act, how they treat others, and the standard they hold themselves to. Counselors should be primarily concerned with the emotional and spiritual wellbeing of the campers at Sacramento Summer Camps. Days are spent getting to know the campers, facilitating activities, leading Bible studies, providing a safe environment for the campers, and modeling a personal relationship with Jesus. Days are long, and can be mentally taxing, therefore counselors should show a high level of emotional intelligence.

## **Responsibilities include:**

- Spend nights with campers during their stay.
- Respond to campers' needs at all hours of the day, including overnight.
- Be the go-to person for the volunteer counselors.
- Provide spiritual guidance and leadership for campers.
- Lead Bible studies and share the Gospel with campers.
- Facilitate activities with campers.
- Ensure the safety of all campers and volunteers.
- During slower weeks, assist Operations or Dining Hall Departments with Housekeeping, Maintenance, Activities, Equine, or Dining Hall needs.
- Assist other departments within the organization when and where needed.

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
