



# Elementary Horse Camp

**Check-In: Monday, June 8, 2026, from 3:00-4:00 pm at Skippers Hall.** At that time, your camper will receive their room assignments, get their nametags, check in any medications with the Camp Nurse, and pay any outstanding balance due. *To help with the check-in process, all medications should be in their original containers and in a zip-top baggie, including an instruction sheet with the camper's name on it.*

**Check-Out: Friday, June 12, 2026, at 10:00 am.** It is important that you review the check-in/out procedures prior to bringing your camper.
