Check-In and Check-Out Information

Check-in: Camp check-in is on **Sunday, June 28, 2026, from 4:00 pm - 7:00 pm at Skipper's Hall**. Skipper's Hall is located to the left upon driving onto our camp site.

- **Room Assignments:** Room assignments will be provided when you check in at Skipper's Hall.
- **Camp Payment:** At check-in, please be prepared to pay any outstanding balance due.
- **Later Arrival (after Check-in hours):** If you come later in the evening after the check-in allotted time, you can find your room assignment posted in the Skipper's Hall Lobby. There is a monitor to the left after entering through the front door, that will have room assignments listed.
- **Need Assistance?** We are happy to help! If you need assistance in any way, please utilize the Call Box located just outside of the Skipper's Hall front door. Press the button down to speak and release the button to hear a SCCC staff member respond.
