Check-In and Check-Out Information

Check-in: Camp check-in is on **Monday, July 6, 2026, from 3:30-5:00 pm at the Family Life Center**. If you need directions to the Family Life Center when you arrive, please stop by the camp office in Skipper's Hall located to the left upon driving onto our camp site.

- **Room Assignments and Name Tags:** When you check-in, your camper will receive their room assignments and get their nametags.
- **Medication Check In:** You will be asked to check in any medications with the Camp Nurse. To help with the check-in process, all medications should be in their original containers and in a zip-top baggie, including an instruction sheet with the camper's name on it.
- **Camp Payment:** At check-in, please be prepared to pay any outstanding balance due.

Check-out: Check-out is on **Friday, July 10, 2026, at 9:45 am**. On Friday before check-out begins, Closing Worship begins at 9:00 am, and you are welcome to join us!
