- Ability and enthusiasm to lead and assist guests of all ages
- Ability to work in a physically demanding rugged mountain environment
- Willingness to perform a wide variety of jobs
- Have flexibility pertaining to work schedule and type of work

Job Description:

Responsible for providing safe and fun activities for guests of all ages and backgrounds. This is a job about people. Summer staff should be individuals who genuinely care about people and their experience at camp. This could mean, but is not limited to, socializing with guests during and outside of activities, ensuring rooms are cleaned to a high standard, and the camp property is properly maintained. Summer staff should be able to provide an environment in which their faith in Christ is reflected in how they act, the way they treat people, and the standards they hold themselves to. Summer staff should be primarily concerned with the welfare of guests. Days are spent facilitating activities, completing various work orders, cleaning buildings, and maintaining the campus.

Responsibilities Include:

- Provide safe and positive experiences for guests
- Performing various maintenance and landscaping tasks including, but not limited to: weed eating, mowing, general building maintenance and repairs, forestry work, general vehicle maintenance, etc.
- Guiding and assisting guests of all ages and riding abilities through various activities
- Maintaining facilities and equipment.
- Follow safety standards as set by the American Camping Association and Sacramento Camp and Conference Center
- Pursue certifications through Adventure Experiences and the NRA (if 21 or older)
- Lead guests through a variety of activities
- Assist in other Sacramento operations as needed (housekeeping, washing dishes, etc.)
