## Check-in and Check-out Information

**Check-in:** Camp check-in is on **Monday, June 15, 2026, from 3:00-5:00 pm at the Family Life Center**. If you need directions to the Family Life Center when you arrive, please stop by the camp office in Skipper's Hall located to the left upon driving onto our camp site.

- **Room Assignments and Name Tags:** When you check-in, your camper will receive their room assignments and get their nametags.
- **Medication Check In:** You will be asked to check in any medications with the Camp Nurse. To help with the check-in process, all medications should be in their original containers and in a zip-top baggie, including an instruction sheet with the camper's name on it.
- **Camp Payment:** At check-in, please be prepared to pay any outstanding balance due.

**Check-out:** Check-out is on **Friday, June 19, 2026, at 11:15-11:30 am**. On Friday before check-out begins, our Closing Worship begins at 10:45 am and you are welcome to join us!
