Check-in and Check-out Information

Check-in: Camp check-in is on **Monday, June 15, 2026, from 3:00-5:00 pm at the Family Life Center**. If you need directions to the Family Life Center when you arrive, please stop by the camp office in Skipper's Hall located to the left upon driving onto our camp site.

- **Room Assignments and Name Tags:** When you check-in, your camper will receive their room assignments and get their nametags.
- **Medication Check In:** Campers are asked to check in any medications with the Camp Nurse. To help with the check-in process, all medications should be in their original containers and in a zip-top baggie, including an instruction sheet with the correct name on it.
- **Camp Payment:** At check-in, please be prepared to pay any outstanding balance due.

Check-out: Check-out is on **Friday, June 19, 2026, at 11:15-11:30 am**. On Friday before check-out begins, our Closing Worship begins at 10:45 am and you are welcome to join us!

- **Check-out Procedures:** It is important that you review the check-in/out procedures prior to bringing your camper. These procedures are located on our website at www.sacramentocamp.org/activities-events/summer-camps

Duties and Responsibilities

As a Volunteer, you will help provide camper supervision in the dorms, at activities, mealtimes, and everywhere in between. You may also be asked to help with the instruction of a small group of campers using a curriculum designed especially for this camp. If so, these materials will be provided to you for your review.

Volunteer Requirements

- 1) A current **background check** (ran by Sacramento prior to your arrival)
- 2) **Child Safety Course** (Sacramento will send you the link to participate in this course.)

As stated during the registration process, these items **MUST** be provided prior to your arrival.

Our target deadline for all volunteer background checks, completion of the Child Safety Course, and all registration and supporting documents is May 20th.
