Ecclesiastes 4:7-10

1. Talk about something you've accomplished as part of a group or team. What are some reasons the "team" was so important?
2. God can use relationships with people to help grow your relationship with Him. Have you ever grown in your faith because of your relationship with someone else? Explain.
3. **Read Ecclesiastes 4:7-10.** These words were written by the most powerful, wealthiest man of his time. Why would it have been easy for Solomon to be relationally isolated? Why would that have been dangerous?
4. **Read Luke 17:10.** Jesus warns about things that cause you to stumble spiritually and emotionally. What are some examples from this day and age?
5. There is no community like Christian community. **Read Luke 10:38-42.** Jesus said that Mary chose the one thing needful. What Jesus mean?

6. Is there anything in your life that you're trying to do (or get through) on your own right now? How can this group spur and encourage you?
