John 4:4-26

→ did something happen last Sunday?

#### #1 Certain moments in life are revealing.

→ Jesus HAD to go through Samaria - **vs. 4-8**

#### #2 Jesus cares about people more than he cares about perception.

→ Jesus helps to uncover the woman's thirst - **vs. 9-18**

#### #3 We fill our bucket with things that can't quench our thirst.

→ God wants our hearts more than our ritual - **vs. 19-26**

#### #4 Understanding the depths of our sin allows us to experience the depths of God's grace.

→ lives and eternities are changed one person at a time

## Group Questions

### JESUS part 3: Conversation at the Well

John 4:4-26

1. Besides faith and family, what is something that you're really passionate about? How does it show?
2. **Read John 4:4-8.** Explain all the things that are surprising about these verses. What do these things tell you about Jesus?
3. In what ways do you find it most difficult to go against culture norms in the name of faith? Why is it so difficult?
4. **Read John 4:16-18.** What do you think of Jesus' approach with the woman? What was he hoping to accomplish?
5. Have you ever had a difficult conversation with someone caught in sin? How did you approach it? What happened?
6. God has called us to share "sin" and "grace" with people. What factors can make it hard or uncomfortable? Why is doing this so important?
7. What does it mean that Jesus wants our hearts not our ritual? Does that mean that ritual is bad? What is rituals proper place?
8. Jesus showed that the life of one person was worth traveling through Samaria and hanging out at Sychar. That's how the Kingdom grows: one person at a time. Share the name of a person with whom you can work to have a similar IMPACT.
