Nehemiah 2:11-18

→ so many things to be brokenhearted over

#### #1 The love of Christ leaves you dissatisfied with doing nothing.

→ thinking and praying from Kislev to Nisan - **2:1**

#### #2 God can do anything through you.

All he requires from you is time.

→ from heart to head to heart again - **2:3-16**

#### #3 God doesn't need our plans, but the people he surrounds us with do.

→ something like this takes us and we - **2:17-18**

→ you represent him, but you aren't him

#### #4 Give yourself room to move.

## Group Questions

### Nehemiah Part 2: Start a Movement

Nehemiah 2:11-18

1. What are some causes or issues that leave you feeling heartbroken? Have you actively done anything about them yet?
2. God gave mankind the ability to come up with ideas and to be sensitive towards issues. So how can you determine whether or not an issue on your heart is "from God"?
3. **Read Nehemiah 2:1.** Nehemiah had to wait several months from the time he became aware of Jerusalem's situation to the time he was given an opportunity to act on it. What value can there be for you to wait when there is a cause that weighs heavy on your heart?
4. **Read Nehemiah 2:4-9.** Nehemiah's circumstances seemed to limit his ability to help at first, but then became pivotal in providing what he needed. What circumstances from your past or present seem to be limiting your ability to move towards a cause?
5. Share some ways how God could be using your current circumstances to accomplish a future purpose.
6. You represent Christ, but you are not the Christ. Why is that important to remember when talking about making an impact in the world?
7. **Read Nehemiah 2:18.** The people in Jerusalem were able to respond to Nehemiah's call to start a movement. In what area of life would you like to give yourself more room to move?
